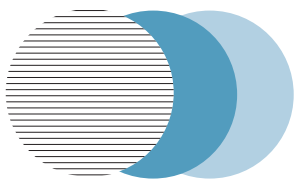

Cuyahoga Options for Elders

Cuyahoga Options for Elders is for older adults who wish to remain independent in their own homes.

Options serves frail elderly who need help coordinating and financing the home care they need, yet are not eligible for PASSPORT* services.

*PASSPORT is a federal/state Medicaid waiver program targeted to low-income seniors with limited assets and functional limitations.

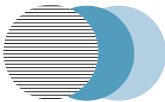

Eligibility

To qualify for services through Options, clients must be:

- 60+ years of age,
- residents of Cuyahoga County,
- living in a private home or apartment (excluding assisted living residences, adult care homes, nursing homes, or group homes),
- eligible for home support services based on an assessment of need for assistance with daily activities, such as bathing, dressing, food preparation, and
- low income with limited assets.
